The chute narrows to about 30" wide at this point so one runner at a time finishes.

This streamlined and simplified finishing chute plan should be followed where possible. Obviously at places like Stages 5, 8, 9, 10, and 19 there will be some compromises in chute placement and design.

This plan uses far less rebar and pvc and eases the amount of these things everyone must handle.

It is most important that wherever possible no part of the chute is so close to the roadway that the follow vehicle has to leave the shoulder lane and move left into traffic.
