

Team Volunteer - Assignment Descriptions



Below you will find a brief description of all volunteer assignments available. Please note that duties and task may change at any time and are delegated by the Stage OIC the day of the race. **All shifts range between 9 – 11 hours and there is no splitting of shifts.**

Available Assignments

- **Stage Support** – (Start Line, Stage 2 – 20 and Finish Line)

Approximately 8 – 10 volunteers are assigned to each stage, including a Stage OIC. Some examples of items that stage volunteers are responsible for are but are not limited to:

- Stage set up and breakdown
 - Checking in Runners
 - Assisting with runners coming in and out of the chute
 - Trash collection
 - Traffic control
 - Crowd control
 - Misc. items
- **Water Stations:** There are 2 water stations along the race route. Both water stations are along Stage 1 prior to where the Follow Vehicles pick up their runners. The distribution of water to the runners is extremely important, especially during the later start times. Some examples of duties include but are not limited to:
 - Set up and breakdown of area
 - Collection of all trash
 - Distribution of water to runners

- **Awards Distribution:** This position takes place at the Host Hotel on Sunday evening and starts prior to the awards show and does not conclude until after the awards show is over. This position may require assisting lifting, bending and moving of items. Some examples of duties include but are not limited to:
 - Assist with moving mugs from one location to another
 - Crowd control
 - Acting as an information runner for OIC
- **Finish Line Breakdown/Awards Ceremony Set Up:** This position reports to their OIC at the Host Hotel at the Finish Line Sunday morning. Those assigned to this position must be able to lift, bend and move items from one location to another. Some examples of duties are but not limited to:
 - Moving bike racks from finish line and placing in rear hotel loading dock
 - Collection of cones
 - Cleanup of finish line
 - Distribution of awards ceremony items inside of main hall
- **Follow Vehicle Check - In:** This assignment is located approximately 2 miles prior to the start line and begins early on Saturday morning. Some examples of duties are but not limited to:
 - Inspection of all team follow vehicles
 - Distribution of follow vehicle tracking devices
 - Assist teams with necessary set up
 - Set up and breakdown of stage
 - Collection of trash
- **Follow Vehicle Staging:** This assignment is located approximately 3 miles from the Start Line. Some examples of duties are but not limited to:
 - Staging of all follow vehicles
 - Ensuring safe departure of follow vehicles once their runner passes the location
 - Collection of all trash at location

- **Messengers:** This assignment is unique in the sense that you are using your own vehicle and can be assigned either Saturday or Sunday, depending on which Stages you are assigned. Your duties include but are not limited to:
 - Driving to assigned Stages to collect necessary paperwork
 - Delivering collected paperwork to War Room at Host Hotel

NOTE: ALL TEAMS MUST PROVIDE A RACE VOLUNTEER THAT IS REQUIRED TO STAY THE ENTIRE DURATION OF THEIR SHIFT. IF YOUR VOLUNTEER FAILS TO SHOW UP FOR THEIR SHIFT OR LEAVES EARLY, YOUR TEAM WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
